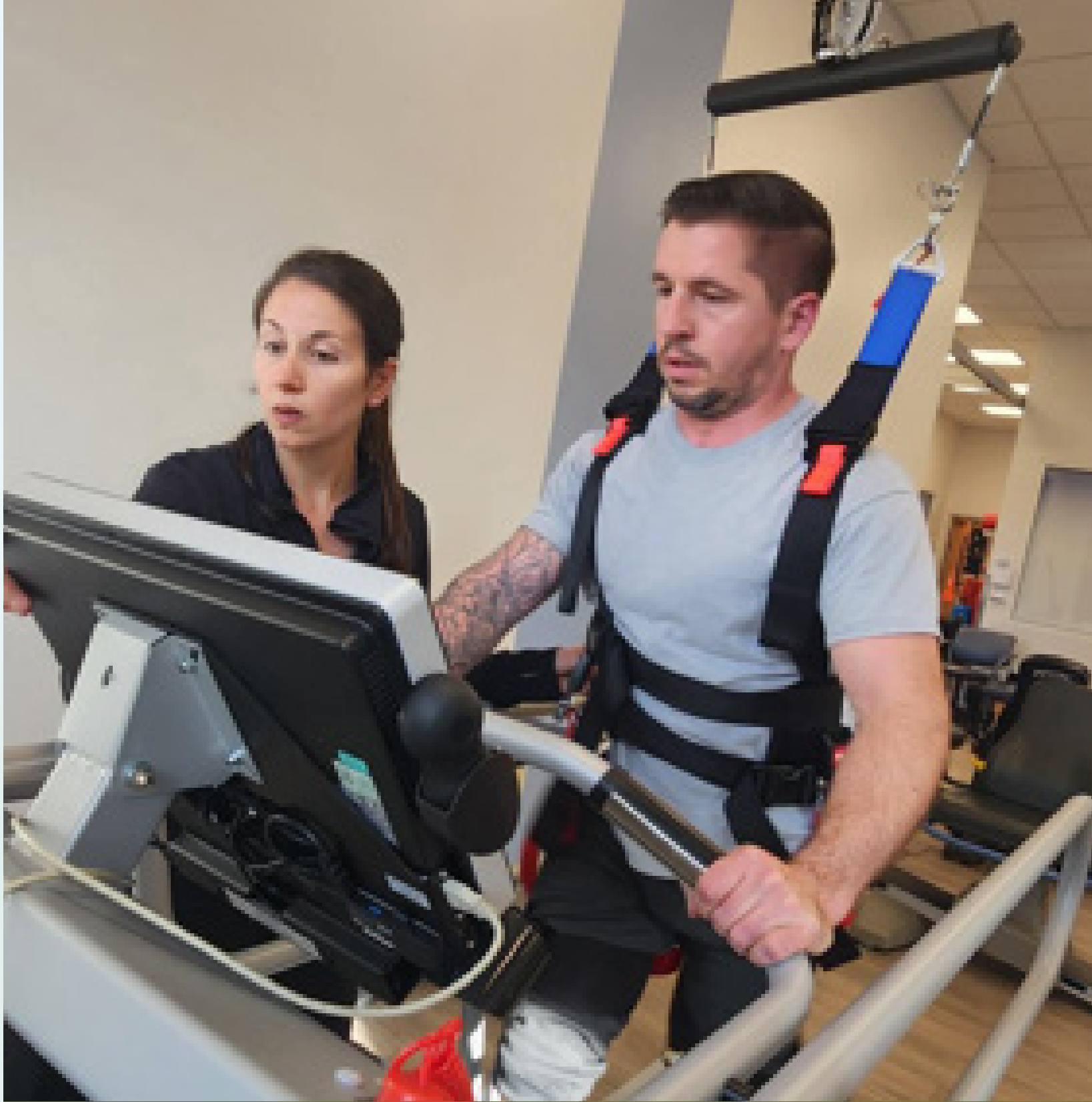

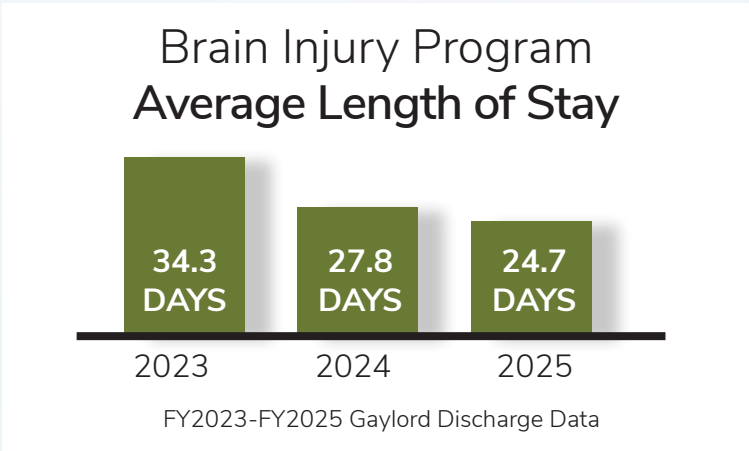
Since every brain injury is different, our **interdisciplinary team will customize a program** based on the patient's specific needs.
