Since every stroke is different, our interdisciplinary team will customize a program based on the patient's specific needs, especially if the patient is part of the **Young Stroke Program**.

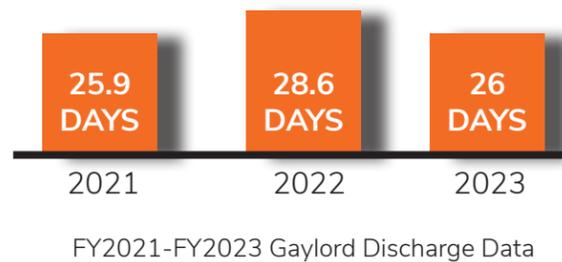
# ABOUT GAYLORD HOSPITAL:

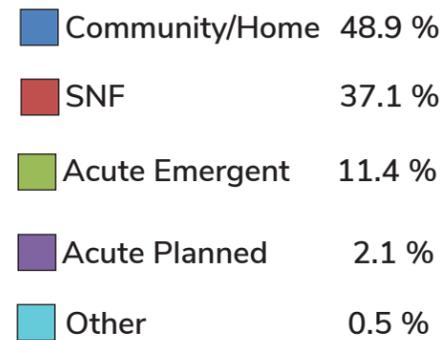
By offering a continuum of care from inpatient to outpatient services, Gaylord can meet the needs of our patients through every stage of recovery.
