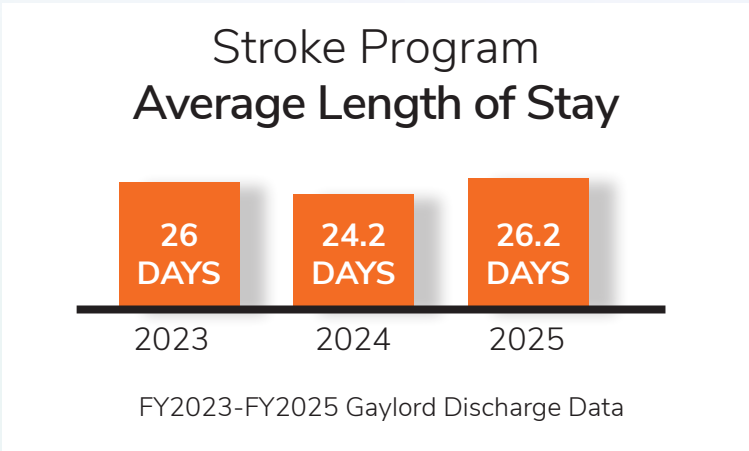
Since every stroke is different, our interdisciplinary team will customize a program based on the patient's specific needs, especially if the patient is part of the **Young Stroke Program**.
