
Spotlight on Gaylord Research

Gaylord is on the national stage! **Nicole Morrill, MSN, RN, Nurse Manager of Lyman 1**, is in Charlotte, North Carolina, this week, presenting at the **2025 AvaSure Symposium**.

AvaSure, a healthcare technology company best known for its TeleSitter® platform, invited us to highlight our own exceptional outcomes from our Telesitting Research study. This study's impacts include a 25% reduction in falls, an estimated \$3.2m in healthcare savings, and an overall impovement in patient safety!

As Henry Hrdlicka, PhD, Director of Research at the Milne Institute, noted: "Often the demand for 1:1 sitters outpaces staff availability... an alternative needed to be found."

Updated Return-to-Work Guidance for Respiratory Illness

Effective August 28, 2025, Gaylord Hospital adopted the Department of Public Health's (DPH) updated interim guidance for healthcare personnel with suspected or confirmed COVID-19, seasonal influenza, or other acute respiratory viral infections.

Return-to-Work Criteria

Staff must remain out of work until **all** of the following are met:

- At least 3 days have passed since symptom onset (or since the first positive test if asymptomatic)
- Fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medications
- Symptoms are improving
- The individual feels well enough to return to work

Upon Returning to Work

- Mask/source control is required through Day 7
- Day 0 = symptom onset or first positive test
- Day 4 = earliest return-to-work date

This guidance applies whether or not viral testing was performed.






