

Gaylord Cup Awarded to Human Resources Department



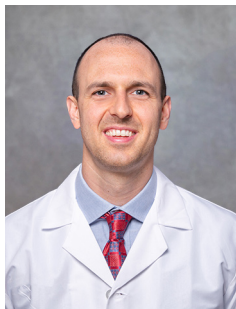

Congratulations to the Human Resources Department for winning the Gaylord Cup in August. Human Resources (HR) was awarded the cup for revising the New Employee Orientation program. Tara Knapp, vice president of external affairs, shared the following when recognizing HR at the September Management Meeting.

Under Mitch's leadership and with the enthusiastic support of his team, the two-day program brings a new flow and schedule that highlights all that is best about Gaylord and ensures our newest employees are well-versed in our culture, policies, and programs. HR reviewed all presentations and standardized the format and background of each to present a cohesive and professional look. Their audit also removed redundant and overlapping messages. Newly added is a Q & A panel discussion with members of MEC at the end of day two. This allows new employees to get to know senior leadership and breaks down the barriers to communication and access right from the start so our staff know they have a valued and appreciated voice.

In addition, the welcoming and onboarding of new employees moves away from the concept of "taking a job" here and instead focuses on enjoying "a career at Gaylord" and positions HR as the employee's "partner" in their growth within the organization. This reframing better reflects the ideals and culture of Gaylord and is to be applauded.

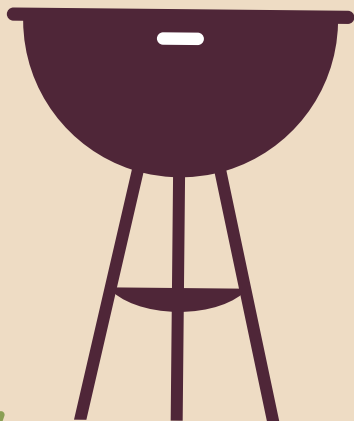

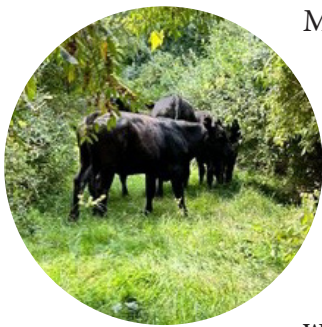

The top twosome was David Allen and Ray Radovich with a score of 33, followed by second place winners Todd Blosser and Tim Ploszaj with a score of 38 and in third place Edwin Quinones and Rafael Reyes.

Jay has been volunteering with the program since 2015 and is currently a golf coach for the Gaylord Sports Association Golf Club as well as a volunteer instructor for our adaptive golf clinics. Near Misses:

Heroic Efforts From Our Safety-Minded Staff

A near miss is an event that might have resulted in harm but the problem did not reach the patient because of timely intervention by our amazing staff.

The Safety Coaches have selected to celebrate the Near Miss submitted in June by Kelani Carbonneau, Pharmacist at Gaylord. Kelani's submission recognized the nurse and LP for their use of the CHAMP tool: **Crosscheck and coach teammates**. The behavior, **Mentor Each Other 200%**, identified the discrepancy in ordering and allowed a correction to be made before reaching the patient. This attention to detail prevented an IV antibiotic from being administered to the incorrect patient.

Benefits representatives for outpatient have long used reports run from Meditech and opened in Excel spreadsheets and then manipulated. In Expanse, the worklists created for this group will allow them to organize their work by specific functions that they perform.

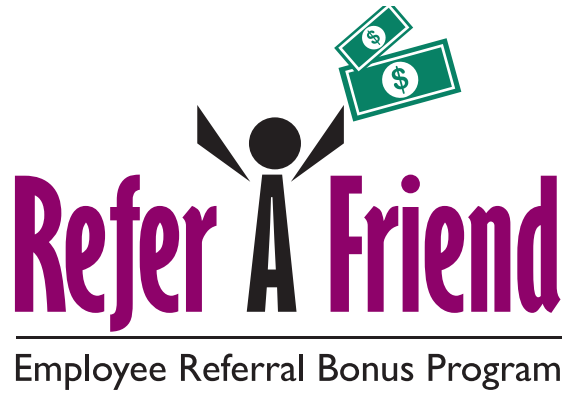

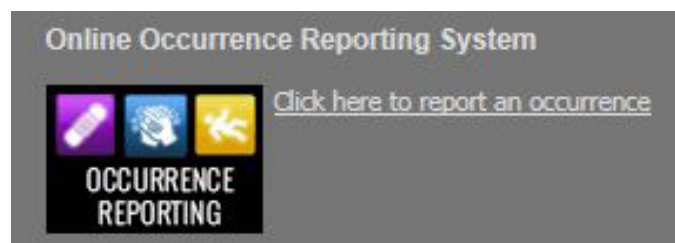

Occurrence Report when you identify a
NEAR MISS safety event.



Why?

Because learning of a **NEAR MISS** allows us to:

- Take action
- Correct the process or eliminate the hazard
- Before the error or problem happens again
- And hurts a patient, staff or visitor

NEAR MISS examples:

- Incorrect diet on meal tray noted **before** it is delivered to the patient room.
- Incorrect medication order questioned by nurse and order corrected **before** patient medicated.
- Incorrect information printed on ID band found just **before** it was placed on patient's wrist.

What is a NEAR MISS safety event?

We call an occurrence a **NEAR MISS** when:

The error is **caught** or the hazard is corrected before it reaches/affects a patient, staff, or visitor.

Includes both when the catch occurs because of built-in checks or barriers, and when it occurs by luck.

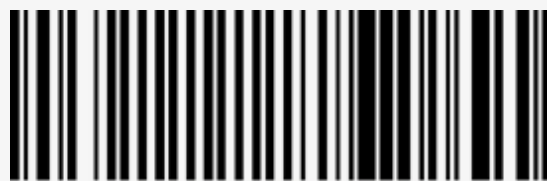

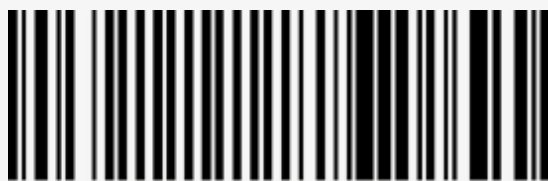
